22. Item 18.1.3 – Lord Mayor's Confidential Verbal Report [C]

The Lord Mayor addressed the Council meeting to give Members an update regarding the upgrade of the intersection of West Terrace/Currie Street for which Council had been unsuccessful on two attempts to gain black spot funding. Ongoing discussions between the City of Adelaide and the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) had been successful in the Government confirming they would provide a funding contribution towards the cost of the intersection upgrade.
