DISCUSSION

- 1. The ACMA Charter (Link 1 view <u>here</u>) was amended and ublishe n the Go ernment Gazette on 8 July 2021.
- 2. Amendments to the ACMA Charter included anges to e c mpositio of the ACMA Board with the TAG Chair no longer being an automatic appointme o the AC Board
 - 2.1. The term of office for previous ACMA Bo mber Andrew Jonats expired on 12 March 2021 and was not immediately filled due to the relew of the CMA Charter.
 - 2.2. The term of office for previous ACMA oard Membe a d Traders Advisory Group (TAG) Chair Ivan Oulianoff ended on 8 July 2 21.
- 3. Pursuant to Clause 4.4.1.2 o he ACMA harter, rd Member Selection Panel (the Panel) shall comprise Council's CEO, the un s sen manager in charge of human resources, the Chairperson and two Council Members. Mr Tom Cready, ac Director City Shaping was delegated by the Council's CEO to act on her behalf on this Se tion Panel. s Christine Locher, ACMA Board Member, was delegated by ACMA's Chair to act on healf on this Selection Panel. Ms Amanda McIlroy, Chief Operating Officer has unde not the role Council's senior manager in charge of human resources.
- 4. Council at its meeting o 14 Septe er 2021 resolved that Deputy Lord Mayor Couros and Councillor Abrahimzadeh be app i ed to be a p of the Adelaide Central Market Authority Board Member Selection Panel for the remainder the 2018-2022 Council term.
- 5. In accordance with Clauses 1 of the ACMA Charter, the Panel undertook an expression of interest process which pene n 30 Au st and closed on 12 September 2021. A total of 53 applications were received.
- 6. The Panel in ividually revi ed the 53 candidates and reached a consensus, through discussion, to short lit d interview six candidates and reached a consensus, through discussion, to short tes based on the skills sought to complement the existing Board Members.
- The Panel undert erviews of six short listed applicants and at the conclusion of the interview process the Panel una imously agreed that John Pearce and George Roussos were the preferred candidates and would be nome ated to Council for appointment to the ACMA Board.
- 8 The Panel in it deliberations noted the key skills that each candidate would bring to the Board as follows:
 - 8 1. John P arce is a specialist in the property and commercial space with extensive achievements in str gy, B2B negotiation, leasing and management including in complex development environments. A copy of his key skills and experience is shown at Link 2 view
 - 8.2. George Roussos has extensive experience in the acquisition, planning and delivery of complex commercial / mixed-use assets and precinct urban regeneration. A copy of his key skills and experience is shown at Link 3 view

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- 9. The ACMA Board met on the 21 October 2021 and were informed of the recruitment process. The Board thanked and acknowledged the work undertaken to present two candidates for consideration.
- 10. The ACMA Board unanimously endorsed the recommendation from the selection panel and asked the selection panel to present their recommendation being John Pearce and George Roussos to uncil for consideration.
- 11. Should Council approve the selection panel recommendation, the two candidates John Pearce and G rge Roussos will be appointed for three years to ensure a staggering of expiry of Board Member terms.
- 12. Consideration of this report in confidence is to protect the personal affairs of the individual whilst uncil considers the appointment of these Board positions and subsequent contact is made wit all app can particularly those who were interviewed. Once these discussions have been ompleted is prosed hit the CEO uses her delegation to release Council's resolution in relation to the matter from confidence and announcement of the appointments be provided to all key stakeholders.
