## Visitor Parking Permit Conditions

## **Visitor Permit Zones**

A vehicle displaying a valid Visitor Voucher may park within a Visitor Permit Zone for the time indicated on the sign only.

## **Parking Exemptions**

A vehicle displaying a valid visitor voucher is granted an additional two (2) hours in:

- a zone where the time limit is 1 hour or longer.
- a ticket zone where the time limit is 1 hour or longer (the purchase of a ticket is not required).

## **Conditions of Use**

The vehicles registration number along with the date and time the vehicle arrived in the parking zone must be written clearly on the permit in ink (pencil is not acceptable).

Permit must be displayed face up on the passenger side of the vehicle's dashboard.

Permits allow parking in the designated areas as defined by Council's Parking Permit Area Map; copy provided with the Visitor Voucher booklet.

Permit is **NOT VALID** in Permit Zones (unless it indicates Visitor on the sign) or non-permissive areas (Loading Zones, No Parking Zones etc.)

Only one permit may be visible on the dashboard at any time.

The extension of time provided is the maximum length of time the vehicle may remain in the parking zone, this time cannot be extended by displaying additional permits. Once the permit has expired, you must remove the vehicle from the length of road.

Permit does not ensure a vacant parking space.

Permit is valid for single use only.

By using the enclosed Permit, the Permit Holder accepts and agrees to the Permit Conditions and acknowledges liability for any Expiation Notices.
