

# City of Adelaide Libraries

## Conditions of Entry

The City Libraries provide friendly, safe, welcoming and inclusive spaces that encourage people of all ages, cultures and means to participate in City life. By entering this facility, you agree to abide by these conditions of entry and all directions from City of Adelaide staff.

- **RESPECT:** Be respectful of other customers, staff, and our facilities.
- **BEHAVIOUR:** Act in an orderly, responsible, safe and lawful manner. No swearing, threatening or violent behaviour, or theft or malicious damage to the facility or other persons property. Appropriate clothing and footwear must be worn at all times.  
**INTOXICATION:** Customers will not be intoxicated by alcohol or drugs or be in the possession of prohibited substances.
- **BELONGINGS:** You are responsible for your personal belongings, keep them with you. No bikes or supermarket trolleys permitted. Skateboards and scooters are not to be ridden onsite.
- **FOOD AND DRINK:** Stay safe by keeping food and drink clear of electrical equipment.
- **CHILDREN:** Supervision by a parent or guardian is required for all children under the age of twelve (12) years.
- **PHOTOGRAPHY:** Seek permission from staff and obtain consent from anyone who may be filmed or photographed before taking or sharing images.

Our staff have the right to refuse entry, remove, and ban individuals who do not respect these Conditions of Entry.
