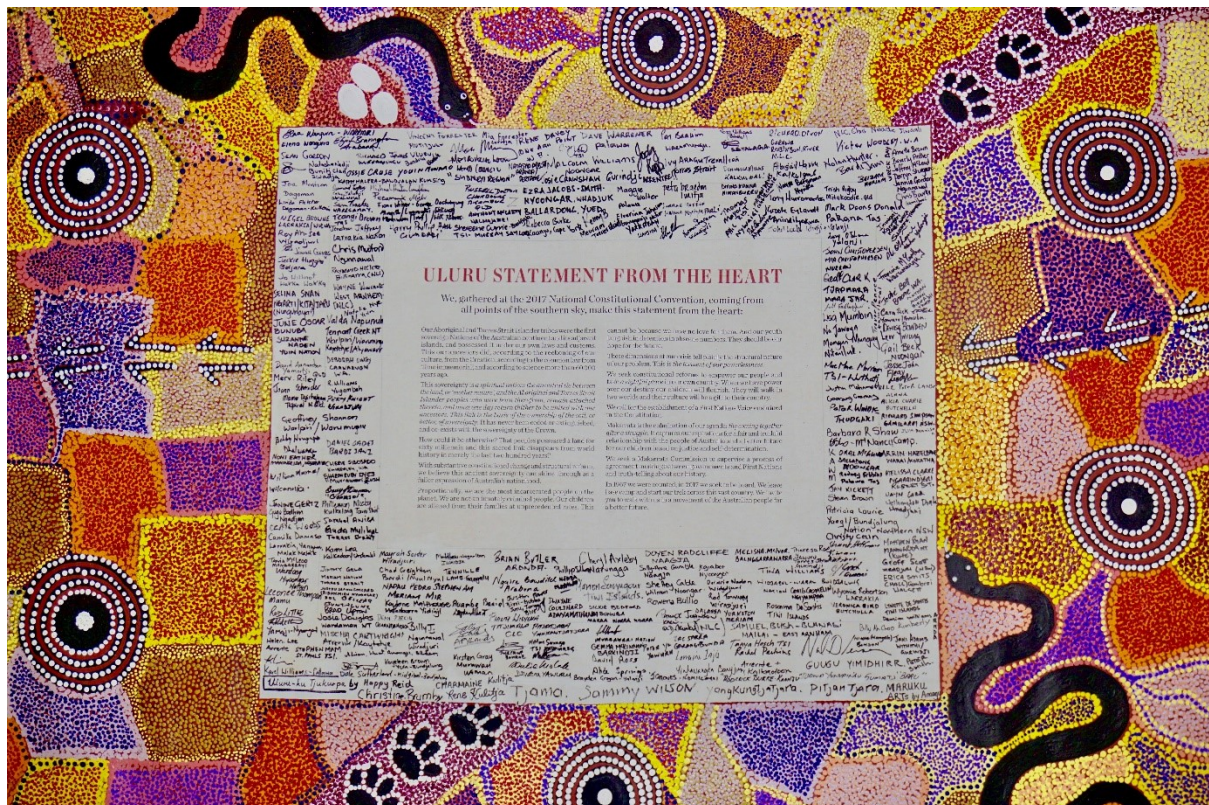


ULURU STATEMENT FROM THE HEART

In May 2017, over 250 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Delegates from all points of the Southern Sky gathered in Mutitjulu in the shadow of Uluru and put their signatures on this historic statement. The Uluru Statement from the Heart invites all Australian people to create a better future through key reforms, called: Voice, Treaty and Truth. The Uluru Statement from the Heart calls for the establishment of a First Nations Voice enshrined in the Australian Constitution. It also seeks a Makarrata Commission to begin a process of agreement- making between governments and First Nations people and truth-telling our history. Acknowledging the first sovereign Nations of the Australian continent and its adjacent islands, recognising the ancestors, customs and laws of this Land that has over 60,000 years history.

The City of Adelaide endorses the Uluru Statement from the Heart and is committed to recognising and celebrating Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people based on three core ingredients – respect, relationships, and opportunities.
