Balya Productions	Give them the Mic	An international cultural exchange between Adelaide and Auckland UNESCO cities of music. The project will provide skill development, live performance, and international collaboration opportunities for First Nations and Maori musicians.
Guildhouse	reVision Philanthropy Program	Establishing links with new and existing philanthropists and private investors, raising funds to deliver a program of support for Adelaide's artists, artisans and creative industries to thrive in the City.
Mercury CX	Emerging Hothouse Scheme	A 12-week professional development residency for three emerging film industry practitioners: a screen writer, a producer, and a programmer/film curator.
True Ability	Unseen	Theatre supporting multi-generational artists with a lived experience of disability, providing the opportunity to showcase unique abilities and an end of year public performance.
The Mill	Why Artists & Studios in the City Matter	Development of a research paper that outlines the value of multi-practice artists and artist studio spaces in the City of Adelaide, with The Mill as the central case study.
Expressions Media	Vaulting Ambitions	An incubation program situated in an emerging arts hub on Hutt St supporting artists, artisans and creatives to grow their business and entrepreneurial skills.
Slingsby Theatre	Slingsby's Flying Squad Audience Base	Storytelling through the capture of city memories, reflected back as a range of theatrical performances in innovative and diverse city spaces and places.
Writers SA	Context: Winter Writing Festival	A three-day festival to activate the city and its cultural heart at Adelaide City Libraries featuring a multi-disciplinary line-up of renowned local and national authors, musicians, games writers, poets and screenwriters.
Adelaide Festival	The Plastic Bag Store	Brooklyn-based artist Robyn Frohardt presented The Plastic Bag Store, a temporary supermarket stocked with a range of tempting goodies made from the "finest, locally sourced, single-use plastic", as part of Adelaide Festival 2021. Audiences were invited to peruse the aisles of this dystopian supermarket coinciding with South Australia's historic ban on single-use plastic products. Frohardt provided insight to her work and process through an insightful artist in conversation session at Adelaide City Library.

Adelaide Symphony Orchestra	Milli, Jack and the Dancing Cat	A new Relaxed Concert that will provide a welcoming artistic experience for neuro-diverse audiences, people on the autism spectrum, and with sensory and/or communication disorders or learning disabilities.
Adelaide Choral Network	Adelaide Year of the Choir 2022	Supporting the Adelaide Choral Network to continue planning towards Adelaide Year of the Choir, a year-round celebration of choral singing across all corners of the City in 2022 that will provide new platforms and opportunities for choirs and connect people through singing.
Adelaide Film Festival	Shorts in Cinemas	An eight-month program of 40 short films by emerging South Australian filmmakers to be screened before feature films in City and North Adelaide based cinemas.
Thick as Thieves	Memory Museum	The Memory Museum at City Library will present memories collected through interviews with community members who work, live and play in the City of Adelaide.
Fashion Industries South Australia	FISA	To create a peak body to champion the interests of the South Australian fashion sector by sharing resources, knowledge, creating momentum and raising the profile of the industry locally, nationally and internationally to grow the sector.
Restless Dance Theatre	Keep Restless Dancing	Contribution to a 12-month program of industry standard training and paid work opportunities for dancers living with and without disability. The program includes behind the scenes performances in the City of Adelaide.
The Mill & OSCA (Open Space Contemporary Arts)	City Mobilities	Workshops wherein participants from visual arts, performance, architecture, urban planning and social sciences will research various city spaces and develop conceptual and physical responses, fostering new ideas about the way participants access, move and engage within the City of Adelaide's public spaces.
Guildhouse	Art Works 2021	Creative and cultural activation of City of Adelaide spaces through a professional incubator model that encompasses artists, writers and art professionals.
Mercury CX	City of Adelaide Mercury Award at the SA Screen Awards 2021	The South Australian Screen Awards celebrate local screen makers and early career creatives across 21 screen craft and genre categories.
Music SA	Go Live	Support for SA's contemporary music industry during COVID restrictions, positioning creativity at the heart of the City's recovery post COVID-19, to support safe and accessible live music opportunities for artists and audiences, and to amplify Adelaide's UNESCO City of Music designation.
Adelaide City of Music Limited	Adelaide UNESCO City of Music	Support the activities of the new organisation in its first year of operation to take the objectives of the organisation forward.
