

Community Centre Spaces: COVID-Safe Requirements and Staff Recommendations

The following recommendations are given with consideration to consumption of food and refreshments and the occupiable space of each hire room and existing furniture and fixtures.

The recommendations are to help hire groups ensure awareness of the responsibilities and that the 1.5m physical distancing can be achieved at a defined public activity at the City of Adelaide Community Centres.

- All businesses, activities and gatherings allowed are listed in the Public Activities current direction.
- Businesses and defined public activities must complete a COVID-Safe Plan and Marshal certificate before they can commence operating and adhere to all requirements. Hirers must also check [COVID Safe activities | SA Health](#) website for current recommendations for consumption of food and refreshments.
- Each hire group using the City of Adelaide Community Centres are required to have a COVID Safe Check-In for their public activity and retain all records as per SA Health Direction.

North Adelaide Community Centre

Accessible features include ramp, parking, toilets, drop off point, quiet areas (Hall) and accessible seating space.

Hall*

Maximum Capacity: 50 people

Area: 179 sqm

The hall has shared access to toilets, adjacent to the back-meeting room.

Back Meeting Room* (adjacent hall)

Maximum Capacity: 15 people

Area: 30 sqm

A meeting room with a projector screen and TV. Shared access to the toilets. An open space, not private.

Small Meeting Room (upstairs)

Gallery

Maximum Capacity: 25 people

Area: 90 sqm

The Loft

Maximum Capacity: 30 people

Area: 125 sqm

Box Factory Community Centre

All our rooms contain tables, chairs, have air conditioning and most are carpeted.

Rooms are accessible for people with a disability with a lift and accessible toilets on both of our two storeys. Ramps, wheelchair access, drop off point out the front of the building (10 minute loading zone), accessible toilets and a lift access to Regent and Hurtle room upstairs.

Carrington Room

Halifax Room

Maximum Capacity: 11 people

Area: 22 sqm

The Halifax is set up classroom style.

Regent Room

Maximum Capacity: 37 people

Area: 96 sqm

This is a large meeting/activity room – contains art gallery space and stairs leading to an outside courtyard.

McLaren Room

Maximum Capacity: 12 people

Area: 30 sqm

A medium sized general use/meeting room off the foyer. Contains our three public access computers that anyone with a City of Adelaide library card can use during our opening hours. Not private Monday to Friday.

Hurtle Room

Maximum Capacity: 16 people

Area: 45 sqm

Open plan dining space with picture windows
