














Gawler Place Upgrade

Fast Facts

Creating a vibrant and green link to the Rundle Mall Precinct and a destination where people shop, visit and spend time.

The upgrade will deliver a pedestrian focussed space and feature new footpath and road surfaces, public art, lighting, seating and spaces for events and socialising. Green elements such as trees, understory planting and climbers will ensure Gawler Place is an attractive, cool and inviting place to be.
