White Markings on Head

- Star – Any marking on forehead
- Blaze – Wide marking covering most of face
- Stripe – Narrow marking running down nose
- Snip – Marking in vicinity of nostrils

White Markings on Legs

- These must be shown as they appear when viewed from both sides of the horse.
- If a white marking extends right around a leg so as to be visible from both sides, it must be shown on the diagrams as seen when viewed from both sides and the rear.

White Markings and Hair Whorls on the Head

- These should be carefully drawn to show whether they are above, between or below the eyes, and their position in relation to the centre line.
- Hair Whorls (or Crowns) are used in most countries as an added form of identification and it is requested that they be shown, particularly in the case of horses with no white or with white markings on the head only.

Other Means of Identification

- Scars – should be shown by an X.
- Hair Whorls - should be shown by a small circle on the diagram. If the whorl is a white marking it may be easier to draw the circle to one side with an arrow pointing to its position on the diagram. It is also important to show the number of whorls in each area in the squares provided.
- Muscle Indentations (Prophet's Thumb) – should be shown as ⊕
- Black Patches – should be shown by outline only (not shaded in).
- White Markings on Grey Horses – pattern markings visible since foaling should be shaded solid, additional grey hairs that have appeared with age should be shaded lightly and described as grey hairs and not as white markings.
- Brands – supply a full written description below and fill in the diagrams.

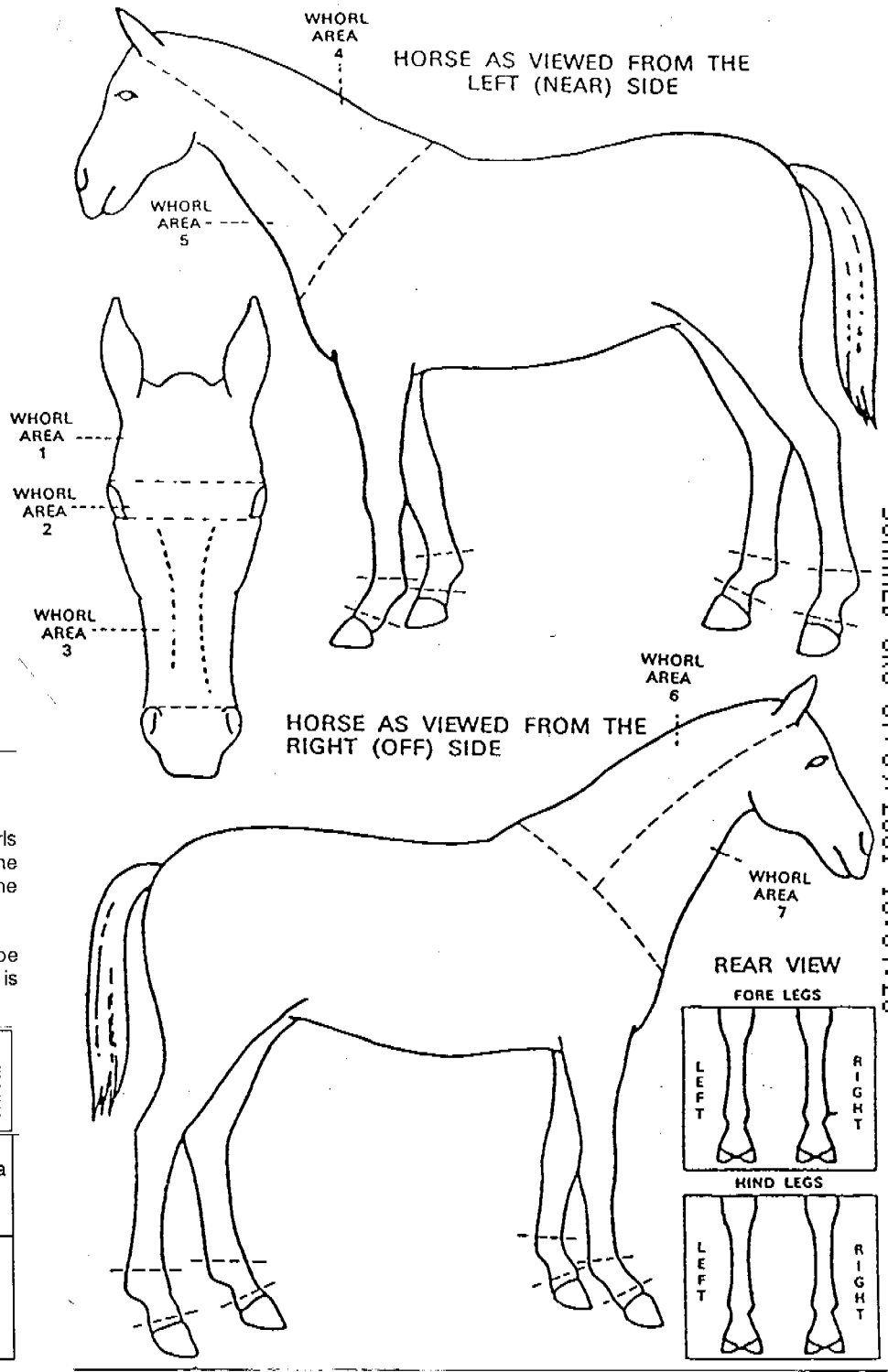
