GAWLER PLACE UPGRADE UPDATE – SHORT TERM CLOSURE AND COMMENCEMENT OF NEW STAGE OF WORK IN GAWLER PLACE SOUTH

This letter is to inform you about:

- What has been achieved so far in Gawler Place
- Short term night closures of Gawler Place south (17 to 22 February 2019)
- A new stage of work commencing on Monday 25 February 2019
- How to stay in touch with us

What has been achieved so far?

Construction works are well underway in Gawler Place. Since our last update in January we have been continuing with stormwater and common services trenches for underground services and utilities. This work is progressing well, with a large amount of new stormwater completed so far in both Gawler Place North and South.

Work has also started in Gawler Place north in front of the UPark, Parc Arcade and Gawler Chambers involving the removal of the existing road and footpath and construction of the new road pavement and footpath.

1. NIGHT ROAD CLOSURE - GAWLER PLACE SOUTH

Gawler Place south between Grenfell Street and Rundle Mall will be **closed to vehicles for five consecutive nights starting on Sunday 17 February and concluding the morning of Friday 22 February.**

The road will be closed on each of these nights from 9.30pm and reopen in the morning at 5am. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

The work involves very deep excavations to enable installation of the future tree pits for the new mature trees to be planted in Gawler Place south. Because this section of Gawler Place is very narrow it is difficult to maintain vehicle access while using large machines for excavation.

Over this short term closure waste collection for general waste and recycling wheelie bins and cardboard collection can occur as usual.

Private waste collection will need to occur before 9.30pm and after 5am on the evenings the road is closed. Please ensure you make these alternative arrangements with your waste collection company.

2. A NEW STAGE TO COMMENCE – GAWLER PLACE SOUTH

A new stage of works will commence on **Monday 25 February 2019 in Gawler Place south** at two locations on the western side of the street. This work will involve:

- Continuing stormwater and common service trenching
- Removing the existing road and footpath
- Construction of the new road pavement and footpath

The map provided shows where these work zones are located.

Pedestrian and vehicle access restrictions

For this new stage of work, Gawler Place south will be reduced to one lane adjacent the two work zones. This means that the one lane is shared by vehicles traveling in both directions with traffic management and controllers in place to assist vehicles.

Loading zones and accessible parks will also be relocated to suit the new arrangements. We suggest that you advise your delivery companies of these new arrangements including the traffic management that will be in place.

During daytime business hours, access along the western footpath adjacent the two work zones will be maintained.

After business hours footpaths adjacent these two work zones will be closed as follows:

- Monday to Thursday – 6:30pm to 6:30am
- Friday – 9:30pm to 8am
- Saturday – 5:30pm to 10am
- Sunday – 5:30pm to 6.30am

The footpath in front of Officeworks will remain open until 9.30pm on weeknights.

While work is underway, the footpath surface along shopfronts will be temporary and constructed in way to ensure safety and accessibility for all people. This includes making sure that entries into shops and buildings are safe.

Waste collection

While these two work zones are in place all bins and cardboard should be placed on the eastern side of Gawler Place south for collection (refer attached map).

Waste collection vehicles are able to access Gawler Place south while these work zones are in place and traffic controllers are on site to assist. Please advise your waste collection companies that they can continue to collect waste from Gawler Place south.

Our approach to construction

While construction is underway, Gawler Place will continue to function as a place where people shop, trade, work, walk, cycle and make deliveries and pickups. Access along footpaths at shopfronts on both sides of Gawler Place will be maintained during business hours and access in and out of Gawler Place will be maintained at all times. Where such work will restrict access in and out of buildings, laneways or driveways, advance notice will be provided to those affected. These works are subject to favourable weather conditions.

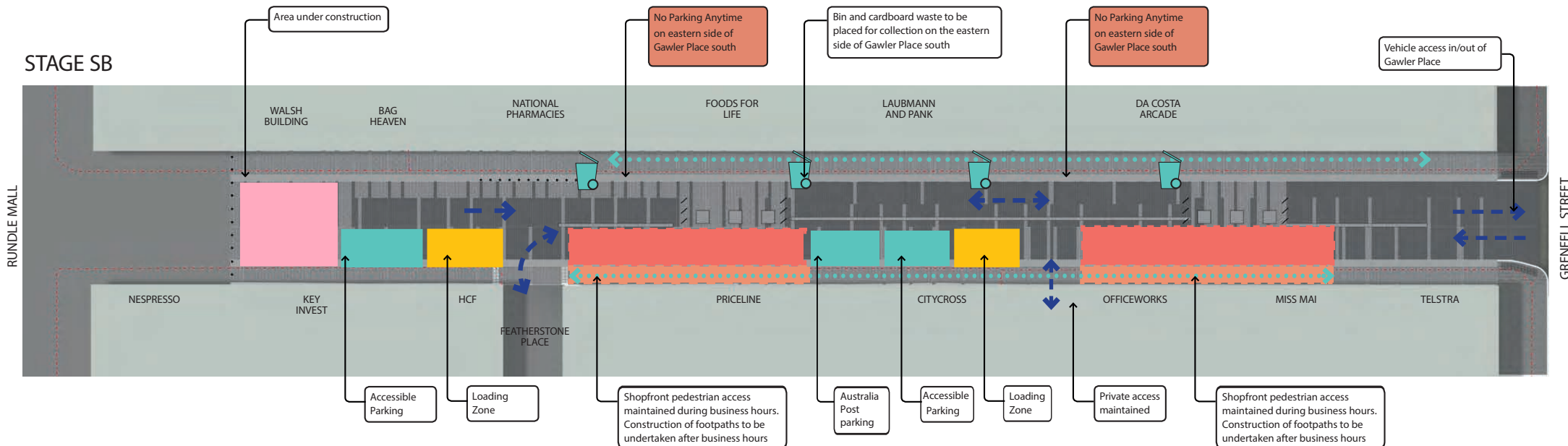
