The City of Adelaide is the government group that looks after the city.



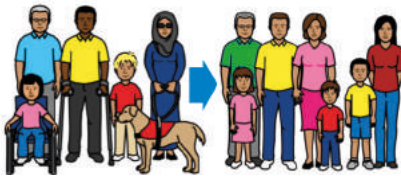
The Adelaide city is the area with the tallest buildings and lots of parks.

The City of Adelaide has made this plan to make sure everyone is **included** in the city.



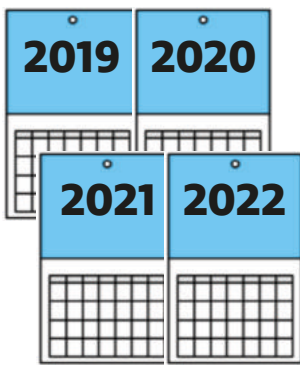
Being **included** means people can join in if they have disability.

The plan has six parts:



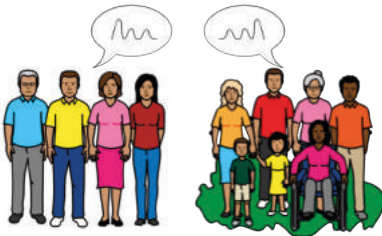
1. Help everyone move around the city.

5. Make sure anyone can work at the City of Adelaide.

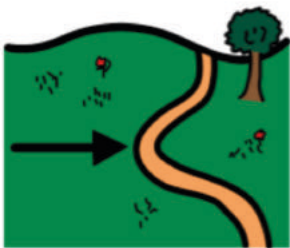


6. Help other parts of Government be better at including people.

- Make it easy to ask the City of Adelaide questions.



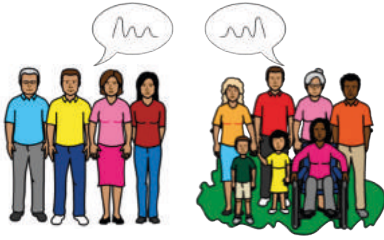
- Make it easy to use the City of Adelaide website.



- Make sure the City of Adelaide website has information for people with disability.

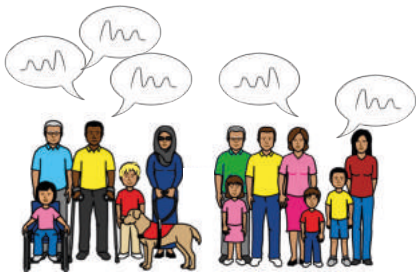


- Help other businesses make their information easier to find.

We will make sure anyone can work at the City of Adelaide.

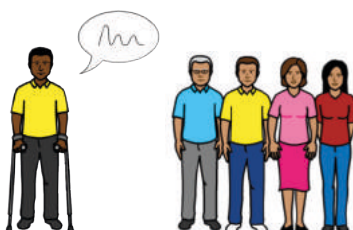
These are some of the things we will do:
