Charles Street and Charles Place, Rundle Mall, Vehicle Access Permits are issued to enable access for vehicles dispatching goods and services to and from retailers, businesses and residents along Charles Street and within Charles Place.

Charles Street does not have any standing permitted.

Charles Place Vehicle Access Permits are not 'parking permits' and only allows vehicles to remain standing for no more than 30 minutes at any time for the purposes of unloading or loading of goods to businesses.

To avoid unnecessary obstructions to vehicle movements, the time a vehicle remains in Charles Place must be kept to a minimum to ensure the safety and convenience of all street users.

- Entrance into Charles Street is only via a left-hand turn from North Terrace.
- Exit from Charles Street is only via a left-hand turn onto North Terrace.
- Charles Street is a single lane road, hosting two-way traffic.
- This permit does not provide access into Rundle Mall.

Vehicles must not be parked in such a manner as to block the thoroughfare through Charles Street, access to Charles Place, or access leading into Rundle Mall.

Drivers must at all times comply with a vehicle speed limit of 10 Km/h.

At all times, drivers of vehicles must comply with the directions of an Authorised Officer of Council, Rundle Mall Management or a Police Officer.

If any equipment, furniture or fittings within Charles Street, Charles Place or any premises abutting or adjacent are damaged by any vehicle referred to in the permit, the owner and driver of such vehicle shall be liable for the cost of repairing such damage and for the value of any property which has been damaged.

In circumstances where a vehicle is sold or no longer used for services in Charles Street or Charles Place and another vehicle is used; the City of Adelaide Vehicle Permit team and the Rundle Mall Management team must be notified to arrange for the alternative vehicle to be registered for access.

Vehicles not complying with these Terms and Conditions may be reported to City of Adelaide for expiation and may have their Permit revoked.

SAFETY BOLLARD – OPERATION

Operation of the North Tce entrance bollards to Charles Street and the Charles Place access gate is by swipe card or keypad code.

The Charles Street bollards have two (2) keypads on the North Terrace side to raise and lower the bollards upon entry/exit.

SWIPE CARD OPERATION

To **LOWER** the bollards, place the swipe card against the bottom (down) keypad – the **RED LED** indicator will turn **GREEN** when successfully activated.



KEY CODE OPERATION

To **LOWER** the bollards, enter the code into the bottom (down) keypad – the **RED LED** indicator will turn **GREEN** when successfully activated.

To **RAISE** the bollards, enter the code into the keypad labelled **UP** - the **RED LED** indicator will turn **GREEN** when successfully activated.

NOTES:

- Should the bollards not lower completely, please swipe your card or enter your code again as per above instructions until they have fully lowered before driving through.
- If entry into Charles Street can't be gained call **08 8203 7203** - 24 hours a day seven days a week. If calling out of hours, please follow the prompts.
