The City of Adelaide has adopted an integrated movement strategy that sets the directions for the use of the road and footpath networks serving Adelaide and North Adelaide, connecting them to inner metropolitan areas.

The integrated movement strategy is an important component of the public realm because it ties together pedestrian traffic, road traffic and bicycle movement into one report.

The general objectives for the integrated movement strategy include:
