Waste Bin (Red Lid)

Waste items placed in this bin go to landfill. Any remaining items that cannot be recycled or composted go in the waste bin.

- Waste – put in:** ✓
- Foam cups/ Food trays
 - Nappies (inc. biodegradable)
 - Plastic bags/Wrap/ Bin liners
 - Clothing/ Fabrics

- Waste – leave out:** ✗
- Dirt/Rocks
 - Hazardous/ Medical waste
 - Electronic Appliances
 - Building materials

Recycling Bin (Yellow Lid)

Items placed in this bin are sorted into groups to be used to produce new products. Place all recyclable material loose in the bin – **NOT in plastic bags.**

- Recycling – put in:** ✓
- Glass bottles and jars
 - Aluminium and steel
 - Hard plastics, cartons
 - Paper and cardboard

- Recycling – leave out:** ✗
- Clothing/ Fabrics
 - Organic waste
 - Gardening tools
 - Plastic bags/ Wrap liners

Organics Bin (Lime Green Lid)

Garden and food organic material placed in this bin is turned into compost, mulch and soil that is used to grow new organic life.

Do not put materials in plastic bags.

- Organics – put in:** ✓
- Food scraps
 - Lawn clippings
 - Garden prunings
 - Twigs/ leaves
 - Small branches

- Organics – leave out:** ✗
- Plastic bags/ Wrap liners
 - Gardening tools
 - Nappies (inc. biodegradable)
 - Irrigation hoses/ Plastic pots/trays

Hard Waste

Council provides a hard waste collection to residents. To book a collection either call the **Waste Hotline on 8159 5001** or visit cityofadelaide.com.au/hardwastebooking

Lost or Stolen Bins

- To request a replacement bin, telephone Council on 8203 7203.
- Replacement of lost or stolen bins requires a statutory declaration or Police report number.
- Waste and recycling bins are the property of City of Adelaide and must be left at the property if you move.

Food Waste – in Your Organics Bin

- All your unused food and food scraps can be placed in the organics (**lime green lid**) bin together with garden organic waste.
- Most things that once grew can be put in your organics bin for composting unless you already compost at home. Contents of organics bins are collected and turned into compost.
- New residents can visit our Customer Service Centre (25 Pirie Street) or any of City of Adelaide's Community Centres to pick-up a free kitchen organics caddy and compostable liner bags to assist you separate and store food waste in your home.

Bin Size Options

Residents who find the 240 litre recycling (yellow lid) or 240 litre organics (lime green lid) bins not suitable for their needs, can downsize to a 140 litre bin (same size as the waste bin). Contact Council on 8203 7203 to order a smaller bin to replace your larger bins.

Upsize Bin – for Residents

If you are a resident and currently have a Council waste and recycling collection service, you may be eligible for:

- An additional 240 litre organics bin.
- A larger 240 litre waste bin.
The new Upsize Bin will replace your existing bin.
- A larger 360 litre recycling bin.
The new Upsize Bin will replace your existing bin.

City of Adelaide Green Waste Recycling and Mulch Centre War Memorial Drive, North Adelaide – opposite the Zoo

- Open Tue–Fri 7.30am – 3pm and Sat 10am – 3.45pm (closed Sundays, Mondays and Public holidays)
- Rate paying residents can dispose of four FREE trailer loads of green waste each year at the Centre
- The Centre recycles green waste into a variety of mulches and compost. Rate paying residents will receive 50% discount on mulch purchases

Electronic Waste (E-Waste)

E-waste is banned from landfill in SA and should not be placed in your waste bin. Residents can dispose of their E-Waste for recycling through Council's Hard Waste collection, or can drop off their E-Waste for recycling FREE at:

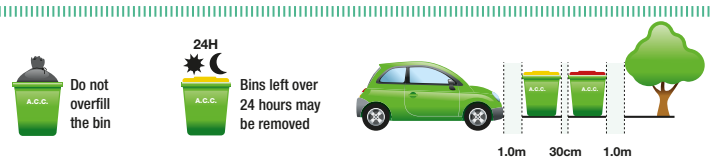
