HOUSES

407, 409, 411, 413 Carrington Street

This group of four almost identical houses illustrates aspects of the residential development of the south-east corner of Adelaide when land prices in the city were at their peak in 1881-82. Following this peak, prices were affected by the misfortunes in the rural sector where successive droughts brought the boom period to an abrupt halt.

This group of detached houses was constructed to fulfil a demand by the rapidly growing city population which doubled in the twenty-year period from the 1860s.

The four houses of this group appear as a terrace unified by similar veranda-balconies and front fence treatment. The design of each house is unremarkable, each two storey unit being single fronted and typically constructed of load bearing bluestone and brick with stuccoed surrounds to openings.

The group mirrors other two storey terrace developments which give Carrington Street its special character, while their scale and style make a positive contribution to the streetscape. To date no record of an architect has been found for these residences.
