### CITY LAND INVESTMENT COMPANY SUBDIVISION

#### Hill, Barnard and Molesworth streets

This subdivision demonstrates with great style the manner in which parts of North Adelaide were developed. It is one of the few subdivisions to remain relatively intact and easily identifiable. The area was redeveloped in 1884 by the City Land Investment Company. It was in the last years of South Australia's greatest boom period and one of the largest and last speculative initiatives encouraged by the financial successes of the period.



There are two plan forms in this subdivision detached villas and semidetached villas. The detached villas are representative of the type of building which gives North Adelaide much of its distinctive character with the asymmetrically placed bays and balconies. The semidetached villas are more eclectically detailed with unusual balcony and veranda forms. Their 'boom' style detailing is distinctive, with few peers in Adelaide. Consent by

the proprietors of town acres 810, 811, 812, 841, 842, 843 and 844 for the City Land Investment Company to sublet all or any part of these town acres was granted on 3 December 1884 by William White, Charles White and J.W. Heathcote.

A contemporary description of this development congratulated the architect Thomas Frost on the result '... whereby Molesworth Barnard and considerably Streets were improved'. The City Land Company Investment had commissioned Frost to build twenty-two dwellings, eighteen of them in pairs, and the remaining four. larger. detached and commodious. A11 were constructed of limestone with cement dressings, and

with a 40 foot private road which still runs at the rear. Fulton and Company, and Revell and Adams raised 18 000 cubic feet of limestone from the 7 acre site for the work which was carried out by E.H. Pert and Son, and Hammond and Moss.

This unified development creates a precinct of great significance, exceptional for the manner in which it reinforces the residential character and scale of North Adelaide:

Hill Street: semidetached houses, 76-80. Barnard Street: house, 74-80 (known as 78); semidetached houses, 66-72 (66 and 68); house, 60-64 (62); house, 48-54 (48); house. 38-42 (40); semidetached houses, 32-36 (34 and 36); house, 22-26 (24). Molesworth Street: semidetached houses, 75-77 (67 and 69); semidetached houses, 59-63 (51 and 53); semidetached houses, 47-53 (37 and 41); semidetached houses, 37-41 (27 and 29); semidetached houses, 21-27 (11 and 11a).
